The 23rd Malaysian International Furniture Fair (Kuala Lumpur) March 08-11, 2017
Putra World Trade Centre (PWTC) and MATRADE Exhibition and Convention Centre (MECC)

The export-oriented furniture trade show, Malaysian International Furniture Fair (MIFF), is set to feature a greater variety of new and innovative products from a wide range of suppliers and four country halls at its 23rd annual edition in March 2017, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, organized by UBM Malaysia.

With posted record US\$908 million sales in 2016, MIFF is expected to feature 500 companies and attract an estimated 20,000 buyers from 140 countries and regions. It will also feature a dedicated segment of MIFF Office to showcase the biggest range of office solutions, with 130 companies at PWTC.

World Showcase

The fair will witness participation from various South East Asian companies, with 70 per cent of exhibitors from Malaysia and the rest from China, Taiwan, Vietnam, Japan, Indonesia and South Korea. The Malaysian companies expected to participate include well-known exporters such as Merryfair Chair System, Euro Chair, Poh Huat, Soon Her Sing Industries, Oasis Furniture and Safari Office System.

The China Hall will play host to over 150 companies, with furnishing exhibitors coming from Southern Guangdong province, led by the China Council for the Promotion of International Trade, Guangzhou Council (CCPIT Guangzhou). Other attractions will be the Taiwan Hall with 30 companies, while Muar Hall, organized by Muar Furniture Association, a strategic partner of MIFF, will feature over 80 member companies.

A Wide Reach

MIFF 2017 continues to benefit from the cross-promotion of the trade show across UBM and Alibaba.com platforms, as a result of a strategic online and offline collaboration to create the next generation of B2B trade sourcing experiences. So far, MIFF has received great numbers from pre-registration, with exhibitors and visitors from over 100 countries so far expressing interest.
